


Curriculum Mapping

The purpose of the course is to develop participants' knowledge and understanding of the curriculum mapping and unit planner components of SEQTA Teach. All non-government schools in Australia are required to undertake re-registration every 5 years, and some form of vertical mapping of the curriculum is required as part of this process.

The Unit planner is designed as a high-level planning tool, to map out topics, adherence to syllabus, content, differentiation and assessments etc and underpins the curriculum mapping facility. The curriculum mapping:

- · enables teachers and school leaders to reflect on the vertical articulation of the written curriculum
- provides a horizontal view, allowing teachers to reflect upon common content and skills across subject groups in a particular year level
- provides a record of how the school organises the subject group through the courses offered in various subjects and disciplines

This reflection enables schools to identify gaps and/or overlap in their curriculum, which may require teachers to modify units and lesson planning.
